Customer Perspectives: Custom Reporting with SQL Server Reporting Services (SSRS)

During this hands-on session, we will use Microsoft SQL Server Management studio and the SSRS report editor to construct reports using data pulled from Synergy. We'll integrate these reports into Synergy using Report Interface Change to attach the reports and pass in parameters to the queries. At the end of the session, attendees will have reports that can be executed from Synergy as PDFs and as drill downs. Attendees should understand basic Synergy data structures and be comfortable working with SQL. Level: Intermediate/Advanced

Customizations Without the Use of Synergy Technology

This hands-on session will guide attendees through the process of customizing screens within Synergy. Topics will include the customization of existing screens in Synergy SIS and TeacherVUE using Property Override and User-Defined Data, as well as the creation of new screens in Synergy SIS, TeacherVUE and ParentVUE. Attendees will leave this session empowered to apply what they have learned to their own Synergy solution. A basic understanding of the Synergy data structure and the navigational elements in the user interface is highly recommended. Level: Intermediate

Synergy SIS Mail Merge 2.0

Want to add a visual element to an existing Synergy report or create a custom report, but don't know how? Then this session is for you! This class is a detailed hands-on presentation geared towards new Mail Merge 2.0 users. Attendees will be guided through the process of creating Mail Merge 2.0 documents for Synergy SIS. After this session, attendees will be able to create their own custom Mail Merge 2.0 documents. Educational technical support staff, school district level staff, education program specialists, and folks in similar roles will benefit most from this session. Level: Beginner

Synergy Rules Engine

The Synergy Rules Engine can be used to place constraints on data fields to ensure data is entered correctly and completely. This session will present an overview of the Rules Engine, including functionality added since the last Users Conference, and provide a hands-on walk-through of the creation and execution of rules. Users will learn how to create person notifications and conditional mandatory fields in addition to more advanced system rules. The use of regex (regular expression) will be covered. Attendees will have an opportunity to try creating their own rules based on what they learn in the class. Following this class, attendees will be able to use the Rules Engine to prevent the entry of bad data and automate person notifications per student rather than having to manually enter the data per student. This class is designed for system administrators. A knowledge of Synergy Business Objects is required, as is administrative access to Synergy. Level: Intermediate/Advanced

Synergy Online Registration

Learn how to customize Synergy Online Registration in this hands-on training session. We will explore the use of email tokens for Email Content, the creation of user-defined fields and View Changes to capture district-specific information, the use of Property Override to change text, and more. At the end of the session, attendees will be able to create custom views to add to Synergy Online Registration. Designed for staff involved in Online Registration Setup.

Attendees should have access to Email Content, User Defined Data, View Change, and Online Registration Setup.

Gradebook Admin Reports

This technical session is a deep dive into the capabilities of Grade Book Admin Reports. It will cover the aspects of the interface, explain the capabilities available to create advanced reports pulling data from practically anywhere in the database, and how to target these reports to any user type. During the session, we'll explore each step of creating an Admin Report, focusing on developing the SQL queries for these reports, custom parameters, and pivot report data sources. Bring your own report requirements to the session and we'll explore how to develop them into Grade Book Admin Reports!

NOTE: For all Pre-Conference Sessions, participants will follow along with the instructor on computers in a lab setting with Synergy test environments provided by Edupoint.



Session 1 - Synergy Attendance Functionality & Maintenance (Elementary/Daily)

This session will review functionality specific to Daily/ Elementary Attendance in Synergy, demonstrating the effects that various existing and new Attendance settings have on the Attendance views in Synergy. You will also be walked through the daily processes of an elementary attendance clerk as you learn tips and tricks for taking and verifying attendance. Level: Beginner/Intermediate

Session 2 - Student Course History & Graduation Requirements

Student Course History and Graduation Requirements are inextricably intertwined in Synergy SIS and can be intimidating to navigate, yet they are integral to a student's collegiate future. In this session, we will unravel the mysteries, discussing Course History updates, manual changes to Course History, the relation of Grading Setup and Student Grade, Graduation Requirement setup, Subject Area hierarchies, and Graduation Requirement connections to the Subject Area Lookup Table and District Course Setup. We'll also cover tricks and troubleshooting tips. Attendees will return to their districts as Course History and Graduation Requirement wizards. (Hat, wand, and robe not included.)

Session 3 - Fees & the Direct Payment Model

This session will present an overview of the Fees - Direct Payment Model and will provide attendees with information regarding the setup of the District Fee Options, Proration, Waivers, Online Payment providers, Family Cap, and Deposits. We will also review District, School, and Optional Fee Information creation and discuss the creation of Student Fees, Adjustments, Payments, and Refunds. Other topics will include Quick Payments, Mass Assign Fees, Fee reports, StudentVUE and ParentVUE Fee Online Payments, Deposits processing and the multiple Fee Sync processes. Attendees will leave the session with an understanding of available features and how to configure their systems. This session is for school administrators, accounting and financial department staff. Level: Beginner/All

Session 4 - Synergy Mobile Applications

Today's world is a mobile world, and you need on-the-go access to student data with Synergy functionality just to keep up. This session will help get you and your colleagues moving by providing an overview of functionality for all of the Synergy mobile apps on their supported platforms. Recommended for educational technical support staff, district level staff, principals, assistant principals, lead teachers, and counselors. Level: Beginner

Session 5 - Scheduling Maintenance & Walk-In Scheduling

Join us for a look at the functionality of the Walk-In Scheduling screen! We will walk through entering student requests on the Walk-In Schedule screen and using the Schedule button to schedule the student into classes. Attendees will leave this session knowing how to schedule a new student. This session is geared toward counselors. An understanding of Synergy Scheduling terminology is recommended. Level: Beginner/Intermediate

Session 6 - Course Requests Three Ways

Learn about entering Course Requests via Online Course Requests, Mass Assign Course Requests, and the Student Requests screen. Attendees will leave this session knowing how to enter Course Requests for students or guide them through the process of entering Online Course Requests in preparation for the scheduling process for the new year. This session is for counselors and anyone who enters Course Requests or helps students enter Course Requests. Knowledge of Synergy Scheduling terminology is recommended. Level: Beginner/Intermediate

Session 7 - New Year Rollover (NYR): Tips & Tricks

This presentation will break down the NYR process to its basic components and give SIS Admin Users the fundamentals that they will need to confidently setup the different NYR process sets. We will also go over some of the more common settings to review, correct, or set up as well as tips and best practices to use while setting up your process sets for success. This session is designed for SIS system administrators. Level: Beginner

Session 1 - Graduation Evaluation Reports (CHS202, CHS401, CHS402, CHS404, STU204)

Several Synergy reports provide information about student progress toward graduation (CHS202, CHS401, CHS402, CHS404, STU204). This session will compare reports, detailing the content of each and the differences between them. The report interface will be described, as well as the data provided on the output. Attendees will leave with an understanding of how to use each report and the ability to share that knowledge with colleagues. This is a can't-miss session for counselors, administrators, and anyone interested in developing a working knowledge of Graduation Evaluation Reports.

Session 2 - Scheduling Concepts

Implementing different types of schedules in Synergy can be a daunting task if you don't know the terminology and capabilities of Synergy Scheduling. This session will bring you up to speed! We will cover Scheduling terminology as well as Scheduling options (e.g., Teams, Houses, Rotations, Wheels, etc.) and how to use them. You will leave with a better understanding of how take your school's scheduling ideas and execute them in Synergy. This session complements our other Scheduling sessions and is appropriate for counselors, assistant principals, district Synergy support staff, and all roles involved in the Scheduling process. Level: All

Session 3 - Mass Scheduling

Learn how to schedule all of your students with one click! This session will cover Mass Scheduling essentials including setup, rules, creating sessions, and allowing the system to schedule all students. For maximum benefit, attendees should understand general Scheduling concepts and other routes to Scheduling (e.g., Course Request setup and concepts). Level: Intermediate

Session 4 - Synergy Online Registration

Did you know that the last few releases of Synergy Online Registration have significantly expanded the product's capabilities? Come get a high-level overview and find out what's new! Attendees will leave this session knowing how to set up Online Registration to better meet their district's needs and goals. This session is designed for district decision makers and for staff responsible for creating and maintaining enrollment packets. Level: Beginner

Session 5 - Customizing Online Registration

Do you know how to customize Synergy Online Registration to match your district's specific needs and capture the information required as part of your current enrollment packets? This session will address how to make customizations using User-Defined Data, View Change, and Property Override. We will look at the relationship between User-Defined Data and View Change and how it works and displays in the Online Registration module. We will also cover the use of Property Override and the Pages tab to re-label fields and text to reflect the terminology used in your district. The session is designed for any staff member who creates User-Defined Fields or Views and for decision makers on information capture during enrollment. Some knowledge of User-Defined Data and View Change is recommended. Level: Intermediate

Session 6 - Test History Overview & Setup

Test History allows users to enter tests into Synergy for the purpose of tracking progress on Standardized Tests or for Graduation Requirements. Learn how to navigate and enter data into the Student Test screen and how to set up Test Definition, Test Import Definition, Test Type, Performance Levels, and Score Types. Attendees will leave the session knowing how to create a Test Definition and set up and use Test Import. Recommended for users who are responsible for entering and utilizing testing data for students. Level: Beginner

Session 7 - Test Import & Test Groups

This session will cover Test Import setup and demonstrate the Test Import process, with a discussion of Score Types, Performance Levels, and the Pass/Fail Indicator. We will also walk through Test Group setup and discuss how Test Groups can be used in Graduation Requirements or CRDC Reporting. Attendees will leave the session knowing how to use Test Import to bring data into Synergy, create Test Groups that can be used in determining Graduation Requirements and compiling data for SRDC Reporting, and populate the ELL Assessment Screen automatically through Test import. Users who will benefit most from this session are those responsible for entering and utilizing testing data for students, including tests used for Graduation Requirements or tracking student needs. Familiarity with Test History setup is recommended.

Session 1 - Synergy - Tips & Tricks for Everyday Users

Are you looking for ways to increase your productivity when working with Synergy? This session will cover several tools for improving your overall Synergy experience, such as shortcuts and advanced processes. If you are a new Synergy user or a system administrator, this session may benefit you. Users who attend this session should know how to navigate Synergy and be familiar with basic Synergy functionality. Level: Beginner/All

Session 2 - Synergy Query: Beginning/Intermediate

This session will provide an overview of Synergy Query with a focus on when and why to use Query as well as how Query functionality works. Attendees will be guided through common uses of Query and how to build basic Queries, and will come away with the ability to use Query to conveniently retrieve data that would otherwise be difficult to compile. Recommended for any user who would benefit from learning how to retrieve data from a database. No prerequisites. All background knowledge will be covered in-session. Level: Beginner/Intermediate

Session 3 - Synergy Query: Creating User-Defined Reports

This session will demonstrate how to use Synergy Query to create custom user-defined reports, as well as how to save queries for personal and public use. Recommended for users employed in data-related fields. A basic understanding of Synergy Query is required to benefit from this session. Level: Advanced

Session 5 - Schedule-Based FTE

Wondering how Schedule-based FTE screens are set up in Synergy and how FTE is calculated?
